





CLUB DINING ROOM

Aurelian blue banquette seating, dusty pink chairs and bold terrazzo set the tone in the Club Room Dining Room, which is at once modern yet anchored in tradition. Art Deco-inspired mirrored detailing and sleek timber wall paneling offset the room's central feature, a handpainted trompe l'oeil mural by Gary Myatt that depicts windows looking out to the ocean. The Club Room Dining Room can be arranged to accommodate up to 60 guests for lunch or dinner.

CLUB BAR

An optional extension of the Club Room Dining Room, in the Club Bar, guests can enjoy classic cocktails and signature libations inspired by The Surf Club's origins. This space features an onyx bar top, high-back leather barstools, Art Deco-inspired mirrored detailing and sleek timber paneling.







BANYAN DINING ROOM

The Banyan Dining Room accommodates up to 40 guests for a seated lunch or dinner. A light, airy indoor space, the room features a clean linen palette of blue and warm coral. A white latticed ceiling and large glass windows with views of the ocean invite sunshine into the dining room. Punctuated with lush greenery native to the region, the space is both elegant and tropical.

BANYAN TERRACE

The Banyan Terrace accommodates up to 100 guests standing or 48 guests seated for lunch or dinner. An al fresco patio, the Banyan Terrace is centered around the historic Banyan tree. Round tables surrounded by rattan chairs and low white sofas make for an intimate lounge-like atmosphere that seamlessly transitions from day to night.

Please note that due to the tropical climate in South Florida, rain is highly likely from the months of June through October. As a result, outdoor events may be rescheduled or moved indoors if space permits. Menu changes may apply and will be at the discretion of the Chef de Cuisine.

BANYAN PRIVATE DINING ROOM

Adjacent to the Banyan Terrace, the Banyan Private Dining Room brings the outdoors in with abundant native planting and windows with sweeping views of the ocean. This intimate indoor space seats 20 guests for lunch or dinner.





Named for The Surf Club's original general manager, Mr. Barton, who oversaw the club from 1930 through the '70s, the Barton Room accommodates up to 65 standing guests for a reception or 50 seated guests for a private lunch or dinner. The space is grounded in a neutral palette of white beadboard and sleek timber paneling. Art Deco-inspired mirrored accents and archived photography by Cecil Beaton imbue the space with a touch of glamour. With various furniture floorplans, this room offers flexibility for intimate gatherings and formal meetings with arrangements of five 10-top tables or one 20-top table.









AUDIOVISUAL EQUIPMENT

The Barton Room is equipped with a complete sound and video system available for rental, which includes:
